CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. This race will be conducted under the 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) with Australian Prescriptions.

All competitors shall be bound by these rules, the sailing instructions issued by RYC and any other rules that may govern the event.

NOTE: RRS Fundamental Rule 3 - DECISION TO RACE. The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is theirs alone. All competitors participate entirely at their own risk. The RYC will not accept any liability for any material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with the race.

NOTE: The RRS Australia Prescription 46 has the following addition 'From 1st January 2022, all persons on board a boat while racing shall be members of a club affiliated to Australian Sailing and have an Australian Sailing number, or hold a valid Sail Pass, or if an international competitor, be a member of a club affiliated to a world sailing recognised member national authority.

3. The responsible person in charge must be 16 Years of age or over unless exempted in writing by the Race Committee.

4. The RYC reserves the right to refuse entry.

5. All boats are to be suitably insured for racing and to be equipped with all legislated safety gear.

6. The above conditions must be certified as acceptable to the nominee and this form signed before acceptance will be considered.
